DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Remove mud and loose material or ice.
- · After opening the laminate foil bag, VIAFIX should be free flowing, if not, return to the supplied together with the purchase receipt.
- Place VIAFIX in the area with a shovel or trowel.
- If the repair is in concrete, shallow or tapering to 0, it is advisable to prime the area to be repaired with the VIAFIX Primer.
- · Level with a rake or trowel allowing the finished level of VIAFIX to be about 25% above the surrounding area, allowing for possible different depths in the same defect.
- · If conditions are dry or even damp sprinkle with water at approx 0,5 litre per 14 kg of VIAFIX.
- · Compact to a level, slightly proud, finish with a handtamper, vibrating plate, or roller. If the compacted material is below the level of the surrounding area, add more VIAFIX, sprinkle with water and compact into existing material. If traffic management is not practicable, simply allow traffic to compact the area.
- If the depth of the pothole is greater than 100mm, it is advisable to carry out the repair in 50-75mm stages.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

- · Each bag contains 14 kg of VIAFIX.
- Store indoors in cool, dry conditions. Avoid direct sunlight or exposure to frost.
- Avoid damage to foil bags.
- All material should be used within 24 hours after opening of foil bags.
- Gloves should be worn and direct contact with skin avoided. In the event of contact, use vegetable oil or proprietary hand cleaners.
- Tools may be cleaned with vegetable oil or any other environmental friendly cleaning agent.
- VIAFIX must be used within 12 months of purchase as the workability can be reduced on prolonged storage
- Coverage rate is approximately 0,6 m² per 14 kg at 1cm depth.

GENERAL ADVICE

- VIAFIX is suitable for permanent repair in all classes of road including motorways.
- VIAFIX hardens quickly to match performance of traditional macadam or asphalt, final settling may take a few

hours, especially in cold weather but trafficking can be instantaneous.

- VIAFIX may be overlaid with any road surfacing material, or sealed with surface dressing.
- VIAFIX will not be damaged by traffic, rain or frost when correctly applied.
- VIAFIX is available in three grade sizes: 0/3mm, 0/6mm and 0/10mm to match or compliment existing surfaces.
